Mandatory lawn watering restrictions specify the days when you may water. These days depend on whether you have an odd- or even-numbered address, and the time of year. So unless your day and number are up, make sure those sprinklers stay down.

Know Your Days

| Time of year | Homes with odd-numbered or no addresses | Homes with even-numbered addresses | Nonresidential properties |
|-----------------------|---|------------------------------------|---------------------------|
| Daylight Saving Time | Wednesday/ Saturday | Thursday/ Sunday | Tuesday/ Friday |
| Eastern Standard Time | Saturday | Sunday | Tuesday |

Additional restrictions include:

- Water only if necessary and not between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Water for no more than one hour per zone.
- Restrictions apply to private wells and pumps, ground or surface water and water from public and private utilities.
- Some exceptions apply.
